- Inspire mixed culture and ability classes, by creating challenging yet inclusive and engaging learning opportunities for all students
- Maintain constant awareness of the needs of any students to whom English is additional language
- Maintain a safe learning environment for students
- Assess and monitor student progress and provide targets so that all learners can see success and improve incessantly
- Liaise with the Head of Performing Arts and curriculum coordinators to ensure effective delivery of the curriculum to specified classes, including selecting resources and managing them efficiently in the classroom
- Assume responsibility for the pastoral care of a class of students through Form Tutoring, paying particular attention to personal development and child protection
- Collaborate with other teachers and curriculum coordinators to deliver an interdisciplinary curriculum and share new ideas, approaches and professional knowledge

- Participate in school activities outside regular school hours to include, but not limited to, school trips, staff meetings, parent's evenings, open days, INSET days, professional development training sessions, conferences and workshops, induction and if applicable examination supervision.
